



Request for Proposal Specific to Engineering Services in Support of Chester County Airport Authority (CCAAA) Corporate Hangar Project

The Chester County Airport Authority is seeking a qualified airport engineering company ("the engineer") to provide land development, environmental assessment, civil engineering and all necessary requirements and design services for a 12,000 sf corporate hangar to be located east of the airport terminal and west of the T-hangars. The engineer must represent the Authority in the presentation of the plan to all required entities including but not limited to: Valley Township, Chester County Planning Commission, and the Chester County Conservation District for review, approval and permitting. The engineer shall solicit bids for construction of the hangar project, which includes the hangar infrastructure, structure, and aid the Authority to open, review and select the winning bidder. The engineer shall oversee the construction, timelines and oversee the timely financial reimbursement of project funding from the Bureau of Aviation (PennDOT/BOA) and the State.

The Authority is seeking a statement of interest, identification of the project team, designating key personnel (names & capabilities) and proposed subcontractors, contact information, and references for similar successful projects (two page limit). To be qualified, the engineer must have experience working under PennDOT/BOA and PA State contracts, with township and county planning committees and the land development approval process.
