

## March 2020 Hot Topics

- **February 14, 2020** - NavTech completed surveying the aircraft apron section associated with the Aircraft Apron Rehabilitation Project.
- **February 17, 2020** - American GeoTech completed core sampling on the west apron.
- **March 5, 2020** – Monthly maintenance completed on ALL driveway security fence gates.
- **March 6, 2020** – Semi-annual NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) EDMR (Electronic Discharge Monitoring Report) were completed and submitted to DEP (Department of Environmental Protection).
- **March 10, 2020** – Terminal building landscaping commenced. Shrubs, trees, and other plants around the terminal were pruned and shaped.

The Airport Manager notified homeowners living on the North side of the airport, that Surveyors would be accessing their property in order to survey the entire airport perimeter.

The Dodge 1500 axle was repaired.

- **March 11, 2020** - Aviation Way drive-thru gate was re-programmed for “Daylight Saving Time”.
- **March 12, 2020** – Replaced the taxiway light fixture located at the Runway 29 run-up area.
- **March 13, 2020** – Completed connecting fence from T-Hangar gate to outer property fence.

The Men’s Bathroom Urinal was treated with a chemical in order to prevent it from clogging.

The Airport Manager mailed out letters to adjacent airport property owners informing them that airport maintenance personnel will start conducting (weather permitting) weed killing spraying on April 1, 2020.

- **March 20, 2020** – Monthly PAPI maintenance and inspection were completed.

Monthly DEP Storm water inspections of South Apron were completed.

- **March 24, 2020** – Volunteers from Revelations of Freedom Ministries did community service at the airport.

- **March 27, 2020** – A light bulb was replaced on the Windssock.
- **March 30, 2020** – Seasonal maintenance started for the spring season.
