

## MAY 2020 HOT TOPICS

**March 31, 2020** - The meter pit at the intersection of Business Route 30 and Aviation Way, was drained of water.

**April 1, 2020** – The Authority is now receiving all of MQS's tenant water bills from Valley Township for dissemination to the airport tenants.

**April 2, 2020** - A street light pole on Aviation Way was knocked down after being hit by a truck. The identity of the vehicle could not be determined and PECO was notified about the light pole.

The Airport Manager and three Airport Maintenance Staff Members reviewed (conference call) the Apron Rehabilitation Project with Delta Airport Consultants.

**April 3, 2020** - A feed-linen was replaced on the handicapped toilet in the terminal building Men's Room.

Volunteers from Revelations of Freedom Ministries continue to assist (community service) airport maintenance staff with the Airport Perimeter Fence line Project.

**April 6, 2020** - The valve on the Men's Room toilet in the terminal building was repaired.

Monthly maintenance completed on ALL driveway security fence gates.

New photo cell sensor was installed on South Apron parking lot lights.

**April 7, 2020** - Grass cutting season officially started.

Plants for terminal project were picked up from Spring Run Farm.

New plants were installed around the terminal.

T-hangar gate problem was fixed.

Weed and feed fertilizer was applied to lawn areas around the terminal.

**April 8, 2020** – Semiannual fire hydrant maintenance was completed on fire hydrants.

**April 14, 2020** - Volunteers from Revelations of Freedom Ministries continue to assist (community service) airport maintenance staff with the Airport Perimeter Fence line Project.

**April 17, 2020** - Monthly DEP Storm water inspections of South Apron were Completed.

Landscaping around the terminal building continued.

**April 20, 2020** - The light on the Business Rt-30 obstruction light pole was replaced.

Repairs were made on two apron light poles. A light bulb was replaced on one light pole and a light bulb and ballast was replaced on the second light pole.

Two light bulbs was replaced on the South Apron vehicle parking

lot light pole.

One of the trees these in the terminal Long Term parking lot was trimmed.

ROFM (Revelation of Freedom Ministry) personnel continue as needed, to assist Authority maintenance staff in clearing trees at the northwest perimeter fence-line.

Monthly PAPI maintenance and inspection were completed.

New obstruction light was installed on obstruction pole.

New light bulbs were replaced in the ramp pole lights and South Apron parking lot light poles.

**April 21, 2020** – Beacon photo cell sensor problem was resolved.

**April 24, 2020** – Terminal and parking area landscape beds were mulched.
